OUT of STATE TRAINING SEMINAR PREREQUISITES

1. Members of the fire company must have an active percentage of 30% and above.
2. Applicants for out of state training programs must submit a letter to the attention of the training committee indicating how the classes and/or instructions will benefit the fire company and fire district.
3. A drill must be instructed with a detailed objective and a drill outline. Failure to instruct a drill after the seminar will result in disqualifying the attendee for the next two (2) years.
4. Applicants must have successfully completed the following classes:
 - a. FIRE I
 - b. FIRE II (grandfathered for subjects who attended FF 1 prior to 1990)
 - c. Motor Vehicle Extrication
 - d. Rapid Intervention / FAST team certified
 - e. In addition to completing the above noted classes, three (3) elective classes must be shown in the specific applicants training jacket, including but not limited to: Engine Ops, Rescue Ops, Truck Ops, any technical rescue classes, any water rescue classes, Basement Fire Ops, High-rise ops, garden apt. and townhouse fire ops, and pump ops.
5. Career staff will be limited to one member attending an out of state training class per year. Exceptions to this may be granted with the approval of the training committee and Fire Chief.
6. The training committee will review the classes the individual is interested in taking to ensure the training will be beneficial to the fire company and fire district.
