TOBACCO USE POLICY

1. The Plainsboro Fire District No. 1 firehouse is a tobacco use free building. This includes but is not limited to cigarettes, cigars, pipes, vaping, (E-cigarettes) and dipping (chewing tobacco).
2. Smoking and dipping is only allowed in the designated location where the cigarette butt receptacle is located or you must be 10 feet from the building. This receptacle is located at the back of the building by the turnout gear room. It is your responsibility to dispose of your cigarette butts in a trash receptacle. Any container used for dipping must be disposed of in the dumpster; dipping containers shall not be brought into the firehouse and disposed of in a garbage can. Please do not smoke right in front of the doors so non-smoking members will not be exposed to second hand smoke and smoke will not get into the building.
3. Smoking or use of chewing tobacco is not allowed in any Fire District or Fire Company vehicle or on the apron.
4. Smoking/dipping is not allowed during a fire call. Exceptions may be granted for extended calls which may include, but not limited to, working fires or motor vehicle accidents. If permission is granted be as discrete as possible. We are a role model to the kids.
5. These rules apply to Plainsboro Fire District No. 1 employees and per-diemers, Plainsboro Fire Company members and guests at the building.
6. Discipline will be as follows:
 - A. Verbal warning
 - B. Written warning
 - C. One day suspension
 - D. One week suspension
